



# MAKE YOUR OWN BUNTING

1. Cut 20 cm (8 inch) squares from fabric.
2. Fold each square diagonally (printed side of fabric together), to create a triangle and pin one side.
3. Sew seam from pinned corner to folded corner, back stitching at the beginning and end.
4. Trim folded tip at an angle to give the bunting a nice point.
5. Centre the seam down the middle of triangle, creating a kite shape, and iron it flat
6. Turn right side out and push out the point.
7. Fold over and tuck in the flap at the top into the triangle pocket, still centering the seam down the middle of the back.
8. Arrange the bunting triangles in a row and sew the binding along the top of the triangles, closing the pocket.
9. Fold the tape over and stitch.
10. Leave about 30 cm of binding at each end to allow for it to be hung.
